### PART V. SUBDIVISION

#### **3 DAMAGE TRIM AND STABILITY**

#### 1 **Paras 3.4.3.2.1 and 3.4.3.2.2** are replaced by the following text:

".1 where the ship is certified to carry 240 persons or more, the *R*-value shall be assigned as follows:

 $R = 1 - 5000 / (L_s + 2,5N + 15225)$ 

where  $N = N_1 + 2N_2;$ 

 $N_1$  = number of persons for whom lifeboats are provided;

 $N_2$  = number of persons (including officers and crew) the ship is permitted to carry in excess of  $N_1$ ;".

.2 where the ship is certified to carry not more than 60 persons, the *R*-value shall be assigned as 0,8*R* determined in accordance with 3.4.3.2.1;".

2 New para 3.4.3.2.4 is introduced reading as follows:

".4 where compliance with the requirements of 3.4.3.2.1 - 3.4.3.2.3 on the basis of  $N = N_1 + 2N_2$  is impracticable and where justification is provided that a suitably reduced degree of hazard exists, a lesser value of N may be taken but in no case less than  $N = N_1 + N_2$ .".
