We hereby inform that the Rules for the Classification and Construction of Sea-Going Ships shall be amended as specified in the Appendices to the Circular Letter.

PART XI. ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT

**19 REQUIREMENTS FOR ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT PROCEEDING FROM SHIP
PURPOSE**

New para **19.9.8** is introduced reading as follows:

"19.9.8 For continuously crewed berth-connected ships, emergency source of electrical power capable of supplying consumers for 3 h in accordance with the requirements of 9.3.7 shall be installed."
