COMMON STRUCTURAL RULES FOR BULK CARRIERS AND OIL TANKERS

Common Structural Rules for Bulk Carriers and Oil Tankers have been approved in accordance with the established approval procedure and come into force on 1 July 2023.

On entry into force, the present Rules replace the Common Structural Rules for Bulk Carriers and Oil Tankers, 2022.
